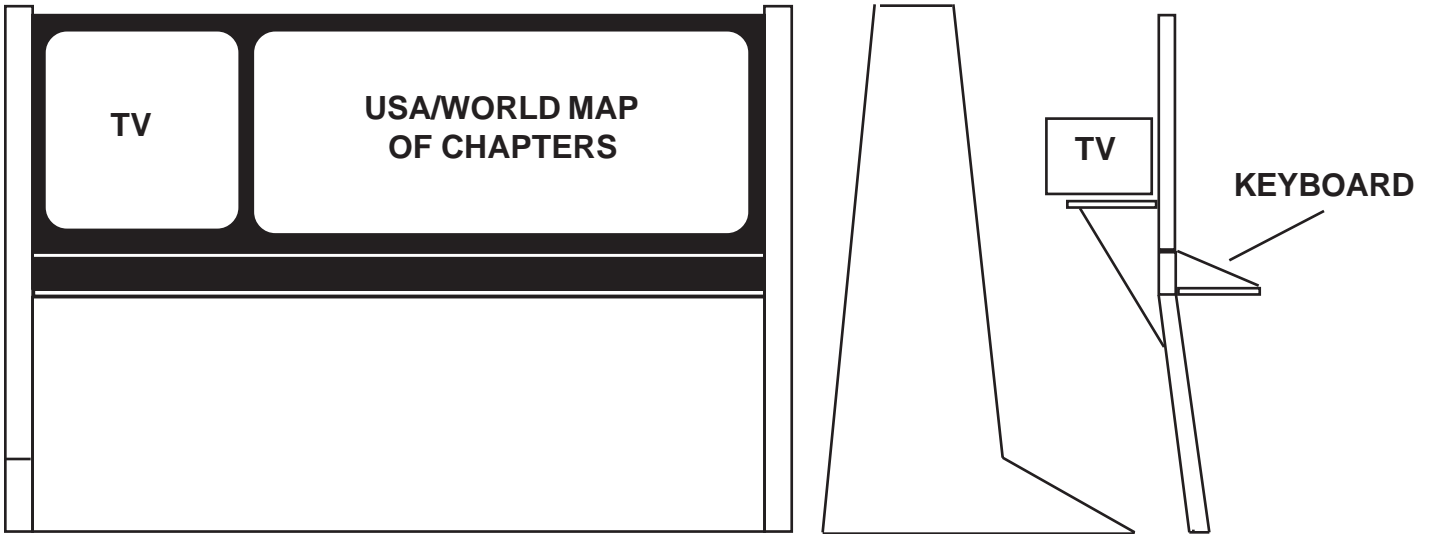


PROPOSED VOYAGER OPS RECRUITING DISPLAY



Voyager OPS Display:

Constructed of light weight plywood as well as plexiglass coverings, will be painted in gun metal grey as are most of the sets of Voyager. Major costs will be the plexiglass and the wood of course. TNG Bridge Display



My first attempt at a multimedia display was framed in 2x2's and covered with tan leatherette. The computer displays were made with plexiglass painted black with areas of TNG computer buttons. Two holes were left for a TV and Computer monitor to run the multimedia displays. The display was great, but constant transport took its toll on the framing and moving in and out of doorways soon doomed the leatherette.

My second project was more of a practical nature. Since we always used a table for recruiting, we constructed a TNG style table for our outings. The table had running lights and a sound system underneath which ran TNG bridge sound effects. The plexiglass and lights drew lots of attention, but was very prone to scratches and was very heavy and finally cracked in half during transport.
